Financial guidelines for taking funds diameter as per target


Establishment of Hav as per the guidelines issued by Government of India, providing basic infrastructure in medical colleges, Gudhivadan - 0300 cells per Haj Jit, 20 MCP, 100 VHPs and one specialist doctor, Ketu computer, phone, printer as mentioned in the guidelines attached with Shahi Rajya Patra. The standard will be followed.

To provide Desimedicine facilities, 05 MBPS doctors have been appointed on contract by the respective medical colleges at the rate of Rs 50-60000/- per month. The said medical officers will provide telemedicine services to the concerned Health and Wellness Center every day from 00:30 am to 06:30 am. For this, necessary training will be provided to the field officers. Apart from the above work, no other work can be taken from these medical officers.

Availability of specialist doctors - 63. Specialist medical officers working in the respective medical colleges will be nominated at each hospital. The program is initially expected to nominate specialist medical officers in Cardiology, Gynecology de Paediatrics. Later the specialization can be changed as per the Health and Wellness Chanter. Every specialist medical officer will provide medicine on daily basis on the basis of roster from 1000 am till 02:00 pm on 08 days in a month. Information about the roster will be sent to all Health and Wellness Centers in advance through the concerned Chief Executive, so that maximum number of beneficiaries can avail the benefit. For this, an honorarium of Rs. 3000/- per day will be provided to the medical specialist. For this, a total amount of Rs. 720000/- per month is being released at the rate of Rs. 50-24000/- per unit per specialist. Is.

Internet Connectivity - Prayaik Medical College IV is being released for 05 months at the rate of Rs. 1000/- per month for minimum internet connectivity of Rs. 2000. Whose criticism will be made on the basis of guest's skin.

It is expected from you that the selection of doctors and experts and the logistics etc. arrangements for setting up N in the medical college/institute should be completed so that telemedicine facility can be provided in the health and wellness centers related to Path Samaar 2019. Instruct the concerned to spend the available amount keeping in mind all the financial and purchasing issues.
