Department of Medical Oncology

SGPGI acquired a Regional Cancer Centre (RCC) in 2005. Departments of Radiation Oncology/Radiotherapy and surgical super specialties continued to provide comprehensive oncology care. The department of Radiotherapy soon felt the need to bridge the gap in terms of providing state of the art and contemporary oncology services. They therefore initiated the process of creating the department of Medical oncology. Following the formalities at the Institute level, the proposal for creation of the department was sent to Government of Uttar Pradesh in 2008, in the year 2016 UP Government sanctioned the creation of Department with the posts of faculty in the Department.

An important milestone in regard to initiation of Department of Medical Oncology, In the year 2020, Board of Studies was held and external experts were finalized for faculty selection.

Finally, the department came into existence by the efforts of the Director, Prof R.K. Dhiman and Dr. Punita Lal, Professor-Radiotherapy Dept was designated as first head of the department of Medical Oncology by the Director, SGPGI in July 2021, also 20 bedded ward for Medical Oncology were allocated in the Bay-2 of Old OPD Area of Hospital.



The First Faculty, Dr Satya Sadhan Sarangi, Assistant Professor, Medical Oncology joined in February 2022 to give the department the much needed boost, whereby OPD became functional for Oncology patients and targeted chemotherapy began to the benefit of cancer patients

Currently we have Four residents doctors who run the clinical services for the cancer patients for solid tumor chemotherapy treatment in collaboration with the Department of Radiotherapy.
