OFFICE ORDER

A meeting for review a dengue management at SGPGI and activation of dengue fever ward was convened on 17-09-2021 under the chairmanship of Director. The following would protocols / arrangements will be followed.

- 1. Department wise roster for effective management of Dengue has been circulated.
- Every department would prepare a roster of one faculty and resident for dengue duties on each of their dengue duty days.
- b. Every department managing those Dengue patients must provide on nodal faculty name for smooth functioning of the area. The department nodal faculty would be the contacted in case of a problem with contacting the faculty/resident on duty.
- c. These details have to be conveyed to the offices of Director and CMS and to Dr. Tanmoy Ghatak, Nodal Officer dengue latest by 25th Sept 2021.
- Triaging: Sick patient with suspected/confirmed dengue and a negative recent COVID RTPCR/TRUENAT report will be triaged in ERS.
 - a. Any patient with suspected dengue with COVID status unknown will be triaged in T3, till COVID negative status is known, after which the patient will be transferred to ward of respective department/dengue fever ward.
- Dengue testing: NS-1 antigen testing, antibody testing and PCR tests are available on payment basis from the department of Microbiology labs. Rapid antigen test (card test) is also available through the 24 hours lab round the clock.
- Dengue fever ward has been activated- in the area previously designed as Swine flu ICU located on 1st floor above CSSD, between the OT complex and HRF.
 - a. Main purpose of the dengue fever ward is to admit stable Dengue patients to observe and transfuse, if they can't be accommodated in wards of the respective specialty.
 - b. Patients admitted to this ward are expected to be transferred to the ward of department/unit on duty on the day of admission for ongoing treatment, or be discharged if stable enough, as soon as possible.
 - c. Sick patients requiring ICU care can be managed initially in dengue ward, till a transfer to appropriate ICU is arranged. 2 ventilators will be shifted from RCH 2.
 - d. Nursing staff has been posted by the CNO, and a roster of the same has been made functional w.ef. Monday 20th Sept 2021.
 - e. Controlling officer of patient helpers, and the nodal officer/supervisor sanitation have posted adequate numbers of patient helpers and house-keeping staff, and provide the roster of the same has been made functional w.e.f. Monday 20th Sept 2021.

- f. Two beds each will be ear-marked and kept available in the CCM-ICU, Post Op ICU and Pulmonary ICU by respective departments for the management of sick Dengue patients.
- Care of Dengue patients: The department designated to care for dengue patients
 reporting to ERS/other areas of SGPGI on any given day would evaluate the patient
 without delay, advise appropriate treatment, and if required-admit to their own
 ward.
 - a. If beds are not available in their own ward, the department may admit reasonably stable patients to the dengue fever ward, till they can shift her/him to their own ward.
 - b. The concerned department will take care of the patient from the time of admission until discharge from the hospital, in whichever area the patient is admitted.

All concerned are requested to take action as stated above for the dengue management and activation of dengue fever ward.
