"Governing Body took note of the adoption of Semester System for B.Sc. Nursing Course as per INC norms instead of yearly session and changes in non-Nursing subjects and approved the same."

Adoption of semester system – Indian Nursing Council under Gazette Notification 05
July 2021 has modified and prescribed curriculum framework for B.Sc. Nursing
program. The new curriculum has been revised to a semester based system. Changes in
curriculum / syllabus by Indian Nursing Council regarding B.Sc Nursing Course will be
incorporated time to time in College of Nursing, SGPGIMS, Lucknow.
