# **Essential Qualifications & Experience:**

- I. A medical qualification included in the first or second schedule or part II of the third schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Persons possessing qualifications included in part II of the third schedule of the said Act shall also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of the section13of the said Act and National Medical Commission Act, 2019. Candidate must be registered in a State Medical Register and National Medical Register except in the case of teachers with non-medical qualifications
- II. A postgraduate qualification recognized by the Board of Governors in supersession of National Medical Commission New Delhi or equivalent thereto (i.e. if a person with postgraduate medical qualifications awarded in the United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia or New Zealand desires to take up a teaching appointment, his/her qualification can be considered as equivalent qualification with MD/MS/DM/MCh as the case may be, for the post of Assistant Professor in respective departments in medical colleges in India), as indicated in the table below for each post, is required. Diplomate National Board (DNB) shall be treated as equivalent to MD, MS / DM, MCh qualifications of the respective broad/super-specialties as per NMC Notification. Issued from time to time.

**United Kingdom**: The candidate should have completed certificate of completion of specialist training (CCST) or equivalent training with final FRCS/FRCP degree and register in that country to practice that specialty

**United State of America and Canada:** The candidate should have MD qualifications with residency training certificate in the relevant specialty in USA. For supers-specialties, successful completion of residency training programme along with completion of accredited fellowship programme in the relevant superspecialty in essential.

Australia and New Zealand: The candidate should have completed supervised training programme culminating in the fellowship of the respective specialty (FRACS/FRACP). For super-specialties, minimum 02 years of supervised sub-specialty fellowship programme in the respective sub specialty is essential.

III. A total of 10, 06 and 03 years of teaching and/or research experience\* at a recognized teaching institution, after the prescribed MD/PhD degree for the posts of **Additional Professor**, **Associate Professor** and **Assistant Professor**, respectively; or 8, 4 and 1 year of teaching and/or research experience\*, respectively, after obtaining the degree of DM/M.Ch (02 year duration) in the concerned specialty; or 7, 3 and 0 years of teaching and/or research experience after obtaining the degree DM/M.Ch (03 Years duration) in the respective specialty as on last date for submission of applications

In subjects where both for broad specialties (MD/DNB) and super-specialties (DM/MCh) qualification is not yet mandated by NMC, special training for 3 years in the respective/concerned specialty in a teaching Institution/Centre of Excellence in a dedicated service recognized by NMC for the purpose will be accepted in lieu of such qualification for the post Assistant Professor.

\*Research Publications: For the post of Additional Professor: 03 research publication (at least two as Associate Professor) and for Associate Professor 01 research publication. Only original papers, meta-analysis, systematic reviews and case series that are published in journals included in Medline, Pubmed Central, Citation Index, Sciences citation index, Expanded Embase, Scopus, Directory of open access journals will be considered

Desirable: Author must be amongst first three or should be the corresponding author.
