AN OVERVIEW

Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences has been established under the State Legislature Act in 1983. It was created by the state of Uttar Pradesh as a Centre of excellence for providing medical care, education, and research of the highest order. The Institute is situated in a 550 acres campus at Raebareli Road, 15 km from the main city. Lucknow is located about 500 Km East of New Delhi and is the capital of Uttar Pradesh. It is rated among the top medical institutions in the country. A highly skilled and dedicated faculty provides quality education and state-of-the-art patient care and is involved in research that strives to meet the needs of society. The Institute awards DM, MCh, MD and MS degrees that are recognized by the National Medical Commission of India. It also offers a PhD program, a 2-year Master in Hospital Administration program (approved by the University Grant Commission) and one-year Post-Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC), One-year Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) & two years Post-Doctoral Advance Fellowship (PDAF) courses in different medical specialties. In addition, the Institute offers several non-degree/non-certificate training positions, such as Senior Resident (Hospital Services) and Junior Resident (Non-Academic) positions in several medical specialties, a Senior Demonstrator program in Molecular Medicine & Biotechnology, Statistical Fellows in Biostatistics and Health Informatics and a Medical Physics Resident program in Radiotherapy.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nationality

Only Indian nationals are eligible.

Essential Educational Qualifications

Candidates must possess, as on 31st March 2026, a requisite qualification **RECOGNISED** by the National Medical Commission of India (except for degrees not covered by Medical Council of India / National Medical Commission of India, where the degrees must be recognized by the respective bodies that approve the qualifying courses). Postgraduate degrees from Departments / Institutions to which MCI/NMC recognition has not been formally granted (for example: under consideration) will not be considered and candidatures of applicants with such degrees may be rejected at any stage (including after admission if this fact comes to notice at that stage).

Age

The upper age limit for eligibility of PDCC / PDAF / Medical Physics Resident/ Senior demonstrator/ Statistical Fellows is 45 years. Age relaxation to a maximum of 5 years may be given to SC/ST/OBC candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh, and to widowed / divorced / legally separated women who have not re-married, and to disabled/handicapped persons, as per Government rules.

Reservation

For Medical Physics Resident/ Senior demonstrator/ Statistical Fellows, reservation will apply as per UP Government rules. Only candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh will be eligible for the benefit of reservation. Reserved category candidates having domicile other than Uttar Pradesh will be treated as Unreserved category candidates for all purposes.

Reserved category candidates should produce certificate of their category in the prescribed format available on website hosted by the State Government. The certificate should be less than 6 months old.

There is no reservation in PDCC and PDAF Courses.

Sponsored Candidates

Admission to various courses is open for candidates sponsored by Central/State Government organizations, universities, or defense services, subject to the following conditions.

- a) The sponsored candidate will not be given relaxation in method of selection, duration of course, practical training, pattern of examination and payment of prescribed fee, etc. except relaxation in age as per rules.
- b) SGPGI will not pay the sponsored candidates any salary, stipend, or any other emoluments during the entire training period.
- c) The candidate should provide a certificate from the sponsoring authority that:
 - a. The candidate is a permanent employee of the sponsoring organization.
 - b. He / She will be granted leave for 2 years/ 1 year in case of PDAF/PDCC programs.
 - c. The candidates, after completing the course, will be suitably employed by the sponsoring organization to work in the specialty in which the training is provided.
 - d. The sponsoring authority shall be responsible for payment of salary or any other emoluments to the candidate during the period of training.
- d) A sponsorship certificate should be attached to the application form, failing which the sponsorship will not be entertained.

Application fee

Rs 1000 + 180 (18% GST) =Rs 1180/- [One thousand one hundred eighty only], payable by Net Banking, Debit / Credit card or through a computer-generated challan form in any branch of State Bank of India through "State Bank Collect". Additional bank transaction charges may apply. The application fee is not refundable either in full or in part under any circumstances.

Option for PDAF/PDCC:

Admission to PDAF (Post Doctoral Advance Fellow) and PDCC (Post Doctoral Certificate course) will be on a merit basis as per availability of the specialty courses. The department of Anesthesiology, in which PDAF and PDCC both courses are available with same question paper

and qualification, the candidates have the option to select either PDAF or PDCC subject to as per their order of merit at the time of the counselling.

Opportunity for Senior Resident (Hospital Services)

Successful candidates who could not get admission in PDCC/PDAF but secured the minimum passing marks for Senior Resident Hospital Services (minimum 45% marks, relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST candidates) may be offered Senior Resident (Hospital Services) at the time of the counselling subject to available seats and fulfilling the eligibility criteria. In case candidates are willing to join the SRHS seats are not available at the time of the counselling, such candidates can participate in the counselling and fill to their choice in front of the admission team. The merit will be valid till 6 months from the date of counselling and during the period in case any seat is vacated the same may be offered to such candidates subject to availability of the seats in the category concerned with consent of the respective head of the Department.

Similarly, after completion of the PDCC/PDAF, in case candidates are willing to continue in the Institute as Senior Resident (Hospital Services), such candidates may be offered an appointment for one year (For PDAF/PDCC) and extendable up to maximum period of another one year (For PDCC only).

Candidates from Department of Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery and Neurology whose PDAF and PDCC entry level requisite qualification is MCh/DNB and DM/DNB respectively (Super-specialty), will not be eligible to receive an additional offer for the post of Senior Resident (Hospital Services) after completion of PDAF.

A candidate can get a maximum of three years appointment as Senior Resident Hospital Services (Including the period of PDCC/PDAF and Senior Resident Hospital Services at SGPGI or any other Institute) after obtaining their MD/MS/DNB degree.

The above offer may be given to the willing eligible candidates, subject to proper recommendations from the Head of the Department concerned and available seats in the applicable category.

Opportunity for Medical Physics Resident/ Senior demonstrator/ Statistical Fellows /Junior Resident (Non-Academic): In case candidates are willing to join the programme but seats are not available at the time of counselling, such candidates may still participate in the counselling and record their choice before the admission committee. The merit shall remain valid for six months from the date of counselling. During this period, if any seat falls vacant, the same may be offered to such candidates, subject to availability of seats in the relevant category, consent of the respective Head of the Department, and approval of the competent authority of the Institute.

Filling of Unfilled Senior Resident (Hospital Services) Posts by Junior Residents (Non-Academic): In case a Senior Resident (HS) position in a concerned department remains unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidates, the respective Head of the Department may request for downgrading the position (in the same category) to be filled from the eligible pool of Junior Residents (Non-Academic) and the same may be available on the day of counselling. Similarly,

in the event that Junior Resident (Non-Academic) seats remain vacant in a department due to non-availability of eligible candidates, the respective Head of the Department may request that such vacant seats be filled from the pool of Junior Resident (Non-Academic) candidates qualified for other departments, provided that the candidates possess the same prescribed qualifications and fulfil the eligibility criteria. The above implementation is subject to approval from the competent authority of the Institute.

METHOD OF SELECTION

The Entrance Examination will be of total 100 marks (Part –A, 60 Questions, 60 Marks & Part–B, 20 Questions, 40 Marks).

An objective-type, examination of **180 MINUTES** duration, consisting of multiple-choice questions. Each question will have five options, and each option should be marked as TRUE or FALSE. The candidate should select the correct answer from the given options in the questions.

Part A: For each correctly marked response, 0.2 marks will be awarded. For each incorrectly marked response, 0.05 marks (25% negative marking) will be deducted. No marks will be awarded if a response is not marked.

Part B: For each correctly marked response, 0.4 marks will be awarded. For each incorrectly marked response, 0.1 marks (25% negative marking) will be deducted. No marks will be awarded if a response is not marked.

In case of tie, in the event of two candidates securing identical total marks, the candidate with higher marks in Part B will be ranked higher and if marks in Part B are also identical then the older candidate will be ranked higher.

Qualifying marks

Selection Process for the Qualifying Candidates:

1. All eligible and qualified candidates for the advertised course/program are required to be present in person at the Counselling Centre on the scheduled date and time, at least one hour prior to the commencement of the counselling process. During counselling, candidates who are finally selected must undergo document verification by producing their original documents along with one set of photocopies and must deposit the prescribed fee immediately. Upon completion of these formalities, the selected candidates will be issued a

provisional appointment/admission letter. Selected candidates must join the respective course/ program within seven (7) days from the date of issuance of the appointment/admission letter, failing which seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate as per merit within any intimation. After the expiry of the seven-day joining period, another round of counselling may be conducted for vacant or unfilled seats. Only those candidates who were not selected in the first round of counselling will be eligible to participate in subsequent counselling rounds. Candidates who have been offered admission must join the allotted course / program within the stipulated time. Change or upgradation of the course/program will not be permitted under any circumstances. If any seat becomes vacant at a later stage, it will be allocated to the next eligible candidate strictly on the basis of merit and as per applicable rules.

2. For PDCC courses, namely Pediatric Critical Care Medicine, Pediatric Endocrinology, Pediatric Hematology, Neonatology, and Pediatric Gastroenterology, the required educational qualification is MD/DNB (Pediatrics). For these courses, the Part A question paper is common for all the above-mentioned courses, whereas the Part B question paper is department-specific and differs for each course. Among these disciplines, candidates who have secured the minimum qualifying marks, are eligible for selection in the above respective course/programme, and have attended counselling but could not obtain a seat in their preferred course due to non-availability of seats as per the order of merit, may request allocation to another PDCC course where seats remain vacant after counselling, provided the eligibility criteria and qualifications are the same and consent of the concerned Head of the department. In such cases, the candidate may submit a written request to the Head of the Department concerned where the seat remains vacant and no candidate has been allotted or reported for that seat, requesting permission to opt for admission in that course/programme. The acceptance or rejection of such requests shall be at the discretion of the Head of the Department concerned. In this matter, in case of any conflict, the appellate redressal authority shall be the Dean. After obtaining the recommendation of the Head of the Department concerning and subject to approval by the Competent Authority of the Institute, the appointment/admission letter shall be issued. In case more than one candidate is recommended for the same vacant seat, or in case of any conflict, candidates shall be considered in the order of merit based on the percentage secured in Part A, with preference given to the candidate securing higher marks.

3. STEPS AFTER SELECTION

Medical examination

No candidate will be permitted to join a course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final. Withholding information about current or past illness / treatment if discovered at a subsequent stage may result in appropriate disciplinary action that may include termination of appointment at any stage.

Joining

If a candidate fails to join the PDAF/PDCC Courses/Senior Resident (HS)/Junior Resident (NA)/Senior Demonstrator (SD)/Medical Physics Resident (MPR)/Statistical Fellow (SF) by the date stipulated in the appointment/selection letter, the offer of appointment/admission shall

automatically stand cancelled. The seat will thereafter be offered to candidates on the waiting list in order of merit. No claim for reinstatement, extension of joining time, or retention of the allotted seat/post shall be entertained after cancellation of the offer, except under circumstances expressly approved by the Competent Authority of the Institute.

Duties and responsibilities

Candidates admitted to the PDAF/PDCC courses shall simultaneously function as Senior Residents and shall be required to perform duties as assigned by the Institute from time to time. Such duties shall include, but shall not be limited to, responsibilities related to patient care, teaching, training, research activities, and emergency services, as and when required, in the interest of the Institute. Senior Resident (HS)/Junior Resident (NA)/Senior Demonstrator (SD)/Medical Physics Resident (MPR)/Statistical Fellow (SF) shall likewise be required to perform duties as assigned by the Institute from time to time, including responsibilities pertaining to patient care, teaching, training, research activities, and emergency services, as applicable. All such candidates shall be liable to be posted, transferred, or assigned duties in any department, unit, or location of SGPGIMS, as determined by the Competent Authority of the Institute, and such decisions shall be binding.

Duration of appointment

The appointment of Senior Resident (HS)/ Senior Demonstrator (SD)/Medical Physics Resident (MPR)/Statistical Fellow (SF) shall be for a maximum period of three (03) years, subject to renewal on an annual basis and for Junior Resident (Nonacademic) shall be for a maximum of 18 months subject to renewal on an six monthly basis based on a satisfactory performance report submitted by the Department concerned at the end of each year of service. The tenure of training for PDCC courses shall be one (01) year, whereas the tenure of training for PDAF courses shall be two (02) years, unless otherwise specified by the Institute. In the event that a candidate enrolled in a PDAF/PDCC course avails Extraordinary Leave or Maternity Leave exceeding three (03) months, the tenure of training shall be extended by a period of six (06) months. The final examination and certification of such candidates shall be correspondingly postponed/regulated in accordance with the prevailing rules and regulations of the Institute, as amended from time to time.

Salary:

Candidates admitted to the PDAF/PDCC courses shall be paid emoluments equivalent to those admissible to a First-Year Senior Resident, along with applicable allowances as per the prevailing Institute rules. Senior Resident, for which a salary of Rs. 67700 Level-11 per month in the pay scale of Rs.67700 - 208700 and other allowances will be paid, as per the Institute rules. Statistical Fellows (SF) shall be paid a consolidated salary of Rs. 37,000/- per month during the first and second year of their tenure. During the third year, they shall be paid a consolidated salary of Rs. 42,000/- per month, along with applicable allowances as per Institute rules. Senior Demonstrators (SD) shall be paid salary in Level-10 (Rs. 56,100/- per month) of the Pay Matrix, excluding Non-Practicing Allowance (NPA), along with other admissible allowances as per the prevailing Institute rules. Medical Physics Residents (MPR) shall be paid salary in Level -6 (Rs. 35,400/- per month) of the Pay Matrix, along with other admissible allowances as per the prevailing Institute rules. All payments of salary/emoluments and allowances shall be governed by the rules, regulations, and amendments issued by the Institute from time to time.

Hostel accommodation:

All candidates admitted/appointed as PDAF, PDCC, Senior Resident (HS), Junior Resident (NA), Medical Physics Resident (MPR), Senior Demonstrator (SD), and Statistical Fellow (SF) shall usually be required to reside within the Institute campus during the tenure of their training/appointment. Such candidates shall be provided semi-furnished hostel accommodation, subject to availability and in accordance with the prevailing rules, regulations, and accommodation policies of the Institute. Allotment, retention, and vacation of hostel accommodation shall be governed by the rules and guidelines issued by the Institute from time to time, and the decision of the Competent Authority in this regard shall be final and binding.

Leave entitlement for PDAF/PDCC/ Medical Physics Resident / Senior Demonstrator/ Statistical Fellows:

Leaving the midway for those enrolled course of PDAF/PDCC/ Senior Resident (HS)/Junior Resident (NA)/Senior Demonstrator (SD)/Medical Physics Resident (MPR)/Statistical Fellow (SF) Program:

Candidates must submit a one-month advance notice period (30 days) in advance or, in case of immediate relieving, submit their resignation along with one month's salary in lieu of notice. The manner of submission of the resignation and its acceptance or rejection shall be at the discretion of the competent authority of the Institute. These provisions shall be governed by the Institute's standard rules, as amended from time to time, and shall also apply to Senior Residents.

MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTIONS

- The date, time and venue of the examination will be provided on the admit card.
- No TA/DA shall be paid for appearing in the entrance examination or for joining.
- The number of seats/posts indicated in the advertisement for various programs is provisional and subject to change without prior notice.
- Any attempt on the part of a candidate to suppress facts, to provide false information or to influence selection directly or indirectly will be treated as a disqualification. If evidence of this surfaces after selection, the services may be terminated and admission cancelled, even at that stage.
- Each selected candidate shall have to pay the fee/dues within the prescribed period, failing which his/her admission/appointment shall be cancelled.
- The selected candidates shall need to have present original documents (medical registration, date of birth certificate, certificates of educational qualification, experience and relieving and good conduct certificate from the University/Institution last attended) for inspection and verification by the Institute authorities and submit a self-attested copy of each at the time of joining.

- The decisions taken by the Director of the Institute in all matters related to the selection of candidates for admission to various courses shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.

If the entrance examination is postponed or cancelled (in part or in full) due to any reason whatsoever beyond the control of the organizers (viz. elements of nature, force majeure or orders/directives issued by any competent government authority), the Institute shall not be responsible for any loss or injury sustained by the candidates directly or indirectly.
