

Notice for the Counselling

All the qualified candidates those appeared in the Entrance test held on 12.04.2026 for admission/appointment to PDAF/PDCC /Senior Resident (Hospital services) / Sr. Demonstrator /Medical Physics Resident, Statistical Fellow and Junior Resident (Non-academic) course/posts are requested to appear in Counselling as per following details.

1. All candidates who have secured the minimum qualifying marks in the entrance examination and are willing to accept the post/position must mandatorily appear **IN PERSON** at the counselling centre. Online counselling shall not be permitted.
2. **Qualifying marks:** Candidates are required to secure the following minimum qualifying marks to be eligible for counselling.

Candidates are requested to check their qualifying status before attending the counselling			

3. Selection Process for the Qualifying Candidates:

- 3.1. The counselling team must reach the counselling centre before 9am. The reporting of the candidates will be started at 9am sharp. All candidates are required to be present and report at the registration counter of the counselling centre between 9AM to 12:30 PM on 2nd May 2026 (Saturday). Candidates reporting after 12:30 PM shall not be permitted to participate in the counselling.
- 3.2. Every participating candidate must sign the attendance register and complete biometric attendance, followed by mandatory document verification before the Admission Committee. The entire process may take approximately 2 hours.
- 3.3. A tentative merit ranking shall be prepared from among the successfully verified candidates. The candidates shall be called sequentially, in order of merit, to exercise their choice from the available seats in the concerned department, as applicable to their category.
- 3.4. After successful seat allotment, candidates must deposit the prescribed admission fee within one hour. Upon receipt of the fee, the allotment shall be confirmed, and such candidates shall be issued an appointment letter.
- 3.5. Appointment letters shall be issued preferably within two days via the registered email ID. Candidates are required to join the post/position within 15 days from the date of issue of the appointment letter.

3.6. Candidates who fail to attend the counselling on the specified date and time shall have their candidature cancelled with immediate effect. However, such candidates may be considered for future vacancies, subject to availability and administrative decision.

4. **Every candidate attending the counselling should follow the steps as given below.**

Steps	Activity
One	Reporting Time: Candidates must report at the counselling centre between 9:00 AM and 12:30 PM. Candidates reporting after 12:30 PM (sign at attendance register) shall not be permitted to participate in the counselling
Two	Verification Process: Biometric verification, Physical attendance, and Document verification from 9AM onwards
Three	Seat Allotment: Candidates who have successfully completed all verification formalities shall be considered for seat allotment. The allotment process will commence from 12.30 PM. Candidates shall be called one by one in order of merit to exercise their choice from the available seats.
Four	Payment of Admission Fee: All candidates allotted seats must deposit the prescribed admission fee within one hour from confirmation of allotment
Five	Fee Receipt and Exit: After successful fee submission, candidates must submit the duly completed counselling form (signed by the candidate and the team) to the Admission Team. Candidates are advised to take a photograph of the completed counselling form before submission, as no receipt will be issued. They may leave the counselling centre after submitting the completed form.
Six	Issue of Appointment Letter: The Academic Section shall issue appointment letters within three working days from the date of counselling via the registered email ID.
Seven	Candidates are required to join the post within a period of 21 days (excluding the date of issue of the appointment letter and the date of admission). Failure to do so shall result in cancellation of the offer, and the vacancy may be offered to the next eligible candidate on the waiting list.

5. Important:

5.1. The admission fee, once paid, shall be non-refundable under any circumstances. Candidates are advised to exercise due diligence and be fully prepared to accept the allotted seat before depositing the fee.

5.2. Candidates reporting after 12:30 PM shall not be entertained for counselling.

5.3. Candidates are required to bring all original documents along with one set of self-attested photocopies.

5.4. The admission fee may be deposited through Credit Card, Debit Card, Net Banking, UPI, or other approved digital payment modes. No consideration shall be given for delays due to travel disruptions, including flights, trains, or any other reasons, and candidates shall be solely responsible for any such delays.

- 5.7. Selected candidates shall be permitted to join the post in the concerned department immediately upon receipt of the offer letter via their registered email ID.
- 5.8. In case a candidate is under a mandatory service bond (Post MBBS/MD/MS or equivalent) of any State and has deposited original documents with another institute, such candidate must produce documentary proof of submission of documents along with a valid No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the concerned State/Medical Education Department or competent authority, as applicable.

6. Important:

- 6.1. Candidates who do not secure admission to PDCC/PDAF courses, but who have obtained the minimum qualifying marks prescribed for SRHS and are willing to serve as Senior Resident (Hospital Services), may, notwithstanding whether SRHS seats are advertised or not in the same or any other department, register themselves in the Senior Resident (HS) candidate list through the respective Admissions Team.
- 6.2. Such candidates shall be considered for appointment against available category-wise vacancies strictly in order of merit, and subject to the recommendation of the concerned Head of the Department and approval of the competent authority.
- 6.3. Provided that the requisite qualifications are fulfilled, such candidates may also be considered for appointment as Senior Resident (Hospital Services) in departments other than the one applied for, based on institutional requirements, recommendations of the HoD, and other applicable conditions.
- 6.4. The merit list so prepared shall remain valid for a period of six (06) months from the date of counselling, unless otherwise notified by the Institute.

Under the following steps: Academic – Fee structure

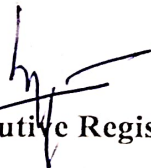
