ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION & EXPERIENCE FOR MEDICAL CANDIDATES

Essential Qualification

- A medical qualification included in the first or second schedule or Part II of the third schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Persons possessing qualifications included in Part II of the Third Schedule of the said Act shall also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the said Act.

- II. A postgraduate qualification recognized by the Board of Governors in supersession of National Medical Commission or equivalent thereto (i.e. if a person with postgraduate medical qualifications awarded in the United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia or New Zealand desires to take up a teaching appointment, his/her qualification can be considered as equivalent qualification with MD/MS/DM/MCh as the case may be, for the post of Assistant Professor in respective departments in medical colleges in India as per fulfillment of Foreign Postgraduate Qualifications for equivalence norms laid down by NMC from time to time), as indicated in the table below for each post, is required.

Diplomate National Board (DNB) / Doctorate of National Board (DrNB) shall be treated as equivalent to MD, MS / DM, MCh qualifications of the respective broad/super-specialties as per NMC Notification issued from time to time[#].

For Determination of equivalence of the qualification of DNB/DrNB with MD/MS and DM/MCh.

The Diplomate of National Board (DNB/DrNB) in broad specialty and in super specialty qualification when granted in a medical institution with attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of five hundred or more beds by the National Board of Examinations shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding broad specialty (MD/MS) and super specialty (DM/MCh) postgraduate qualification. For the purposes of equivalence in teaching, persons holding a Diplomate of National Board qualification in broad specialty obtained from medical institutions with a bed strength of less than 500 shall be required to complete an additional one-year senior residency in a recognized medical institution in the relevant specialty.

Post DNB/MD/MS, a 3-year DrNB course and, in case of direct entry at MBBS, a 6-year DrNB Program must be completed from a recognized institute/medical college from NBEMS. The candidate should be registered for DrNB training in the respective course and should have passed the final exit examination leading to the award of DNB/DrNB qualification. A certificate from the recognized Commission should be provided by the candidate.

Experience

- III. A total of **14, 10, 06 and 03 years** of teaching and research experience at a recognized teaching institution, after the prescribed MD/DNB degree for the posts of Professor, Additional Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor, respectively, of which 03 years as Senior Resident in a teaching/training institute recognized by NMC, New Delhi is mandatory. #

OR

A total of **12, 8, 4 and 1 years** of teaching and research experience, respectively, after obtaining the degree of DM/M.Ch/DrNB (2 years or 5 years course recognized after MBBS) in the concerned specialty. #

****Those who have not completed Basic Course in Biomedical Research (BCBR) may complete it within one year after joining.**

#Faculty serving in super specialty departments or in broad specialty subjects not included in the undergraduate curriculum shall be exempt from the requirement to undergo the basic course in medical education
