Mandatory Documents:

1. Self-attested copies of mark sheets for 10th, 12th, Graduation and other requisite qualifications (as applicable).
2. Experience Certificate (as applicable).
3. No Objection Certificate (NOC) from cadre-controlling authority (if applicable)
4. Integrity Certificate.
5. Caste & Domicile Certificates.

Reservation:

- Reservation benefits are applicable as per Uttar Pradesh Government rules.
- Only domiciles of Uttar Pradesh will be eligible for reservation benefits.

Age –Limit:

1. The decisive date of age & requisite qualification calculation for recruitment to all the posts of the Institute is 1st January, (in case if Advt. is released in between 1st January to 30th June) and 1st July (in case if Advt. is released in between 1st July to 31st December) of that year. As such in the instant advertisement the decisive date is 1st July 2026, the candidate has attained the age of 18 years and has not attained the age of more than 50 years for Specialist Medical Officer Gr. II.
2. In case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBCs and other such categories of candidates in Uttar Pradesh, the upper age limit will be as high as specified by the Government.
3. In case of Permanent Government Employees of Government of UP who have rendered not less than 3 years regular and continuous service in the relevant field, the age is relaxable up to maximum period of 5 years as per GOs of Govt of UP, Karmik Anubhag -4 Ref No. -2-E.M./2001-Ka-42013 dated 27.08.2013.
4. For appointment on direct entry posts an ex-service man vide U.P.Govt Niyukti (kha) depts no. 5/1/66-niyukti (kha) dated 16.3.1970, he shall be allowed to deduct the period of his service in the armed forces from his actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post / service for which he seek

appointment by more than 03 years, he shall be deemed to satisfy the condition regarding the upper age limit. However, he should have rendered satisfactory approved military service in any wing of army, navy or air forces and he should be otherwise eligible for the post.

Selection Process:

- **Selection will be based on an Interview in order of merit.**

General Instructions:

1. Candidates from reserved categories must mention their category in the application.
2. If a candidate belongs to multiple reserved categories, only one most beneficial relaxation will be granted.
3. In the case of female candidates, reservation shall be applicable on the basis of the category of the father.
4. Employees from Central/State Government services must provide an **NOC** from their employer.

1. Any false information in the application will lead to disqualification of candidature.
2. The date of birth mentioned in the Class X Certificate will be considered final.
3. Candidates must submit self-attested copies of testimonials / certificates with the application form.
