## **Walk in Interview Notice for Short term (89 days) Appointment**

Applications are invited for the vacant posts of short-term Senior Resident (Hospital Services)/ Junior Resident (Non-Academic)/ Medical Physics Resident/ Statistical Fellows and Senior Demonstrator throughout the year subject to available post in the advertisement. The above post to be filled through walk in interview for appointment of a period of 89 days only. The details are as under: -

**Date and Day of Walk in Interview:** Last Friday of every month. In case there is holiday on Friday, interview will be shifted to following Saturday. In case Saturday is also holiday it will be held on next following working day.

**Document verification:** In the office of the concerned department, during 10.30hrs to 13.30hrs

**Interview Venue:** Telemedicine Auditorium, School of Telemedicine, SGPGIMS.  
Time 14.00hrs -16.00hrs.

### **General Information:**

1. The vacant post for walk in interview will be available at institute website on or before of 15<sup>th</sup> day of every month.
2. The candidate is advised to see the available seat matrix (after 15th day of every month) at institute website before planning to participate for the walk-in interview.
3. All the prospective eligible candidates are required to appear for a walk-in interview **IN PERSON**, along with their original documents and two sets of the photocopy of the same.
4. Every participating candidate must affix his/her signature on the attendance register and undergo mandatory document verification before the admission committee of the concerned department, which is available in the department from 10.30 to 13.30
5. From the successfully verified candidates, they subsequently appear in the interview at the Telemedicine auditorium, 14.00hrs -16.00hrs.
6. All such selected candidates will receive the appointment letter within 5working days on their email id. Each selected candidate must join the post / positions within 07 days from the date of the receiving the appointment letter in his/her email.
7. In case a candidate does not join the post within the given period, the candidature will be forfeited without any further notice, with immediate effect, and next waitlisted candidate will be offered.

### **Other Terms and conditions:**

1. The number of published posts may be increased or decreased.
2. A candidate can get a short-term appointment maximum for an additional of two terms (a total of three terms including first appointment each of a maximum of 89 days with cooling period) subject to satisfactory performance report and recommendation from the respective head of the department and availability of the seats in the applicable category.
3. Each appointment will be for next 89 days OR up to regular appointment (through entrance test) whichever is earlier.

4. In case seat of the particular-reserved category is vacant due to no eligible candidate appearing in the interview or candidate not found suitable, in that situation same seat will be offered to other category candidate in the chronological order given below.
5. If seat is marked for SC/ST category in absence of SC/ST category candidate, seat will be offered to OBC category. In absence of OBC category, seat will be filled by Unreserved category. Similarly, if seat is marked for OBC category in absence of OBC category candidate, seat will be offered to Unreserved category.
6. A candidate selected in the seat of the other than his/her applicable category, appointment cannot be renewed after 89 days, and such candidate must appear in a fresh interview for further possible selection. In case his/her category seat is not available and other category seat is vacant, but no eligible candidate is available to fill up the seat, then such candidate can occupy again the seats if selected. Although such candidates need to mandatorily appear afresh in the subsequent interview on each occasion if desired for continuing the said post.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

1. **Nationality:** Only Indian nationals are eligible. Essential Educational Qualifications Candidates must possess, as on 15<sup>th</sup> day of the concerned month (example candidate appearing in interview in the month of August 2024 then candidate must possess all the eligibility criteria on or before of 15<sup>th</sup> August 2024), a requisite qualification RECOGNISED by the National Medical Commission of India (except for degrees not covered by Medical Council of India / National Medical Commission of India, where the degrees must be recognized by the respective bodies that approve the qualifying courses). Postgraduate degrees from Departments / Institutions to which MCI/NMC recognition has not been formally granted (for example: under consideration) will not be considered and candidature of applicants with such degrees may be rejected at any stage (including after admission if this fact comes to notice at that stage),
2. **Age:** The upper age limit for eligibility of Senior Residents/ Medical Physics Resident/ Senior demonstrator/ Statistical Fellows is 45 years whereas for the Junior Resident (Non-academic) is 30 years as reckoned on 15<sup>th</sup> day of the concerned month of interview. Age relaxation to a maximum of 5 years may be given to SC/ST/OBC candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh, and to widowed / divorced / legally separated women who have not re-married, and to disabled/handicapped persons, as per Government rules for Senior Resident posts only.
3. **Reservation:** Reservation will apply as per UP Government rules. Only candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh will be eligible for the benefit of reservation. Reserved category candidates having domicile other than Uttar Pradesh will be treated as Unreserved category candidates for all purposes. Reserved category candidates should produce certificate of their category in the prescribed format available on website hosted by the State Government. The certificate should be only for OBC candidates less than 6 months old.

### **Fee, Mode of Payment and Essential documents:**

1. The Candidates should fill the prescribed application form (attached with the advertisement) and submit it in the concerned department at the time of document verification. The following documents must be attached with the filled application form.
  - a. Curriculum Vitae (updated)
  - b. Passport size photographs (6 Nos) facing camera, clearly visible light background. The photograph submitted must be recent and not over a month old
  - c. Certificate for proof of age (Only high school certificate is accepted).
  - d. Self-certified photocopy of all relevant certificates and testimonials.

### **Salary/ Emoluments:**

**Senior Resident (Hospital services):** Level 11 i.e. Rs.67700-208700 and other allowances will be paid, as per the Institute rules.

**Junior Resident (Non-academic):** Level 10 i.e. Rs.56100/- and other allowances will be paid, as per the Institute rules.

**Medical Physics Resident (MPR):** Level 6 i.e. Rs. 35400/- and other allowances (except NPA), as per the Institute rules.

**Statistical Fellows:** Rs. 37,000/- per month and other allowances (except NPA), as per the Institute rules.

**Senior Demonstrator:** Rs. 56100 per month and other allowances (except NPA), as per the Institute rules

### **STEPS AFTER SELECTION:**

#### **Medical examination**

No candidate will be permitted to join a course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final. Withholding information about current or past illness / treatment if discovered at a subsequent stage may result in appropriate disciplinary action that may include termination of appointment at any stage.

## Joining

If a candidate fails to join the positions by the date stipulated in the appointment /selection letter, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled, and the seat will be offered to candidates in the waiting list in order of merit.

**Admission Fee:** There is no admission fee for the short-term appointments.

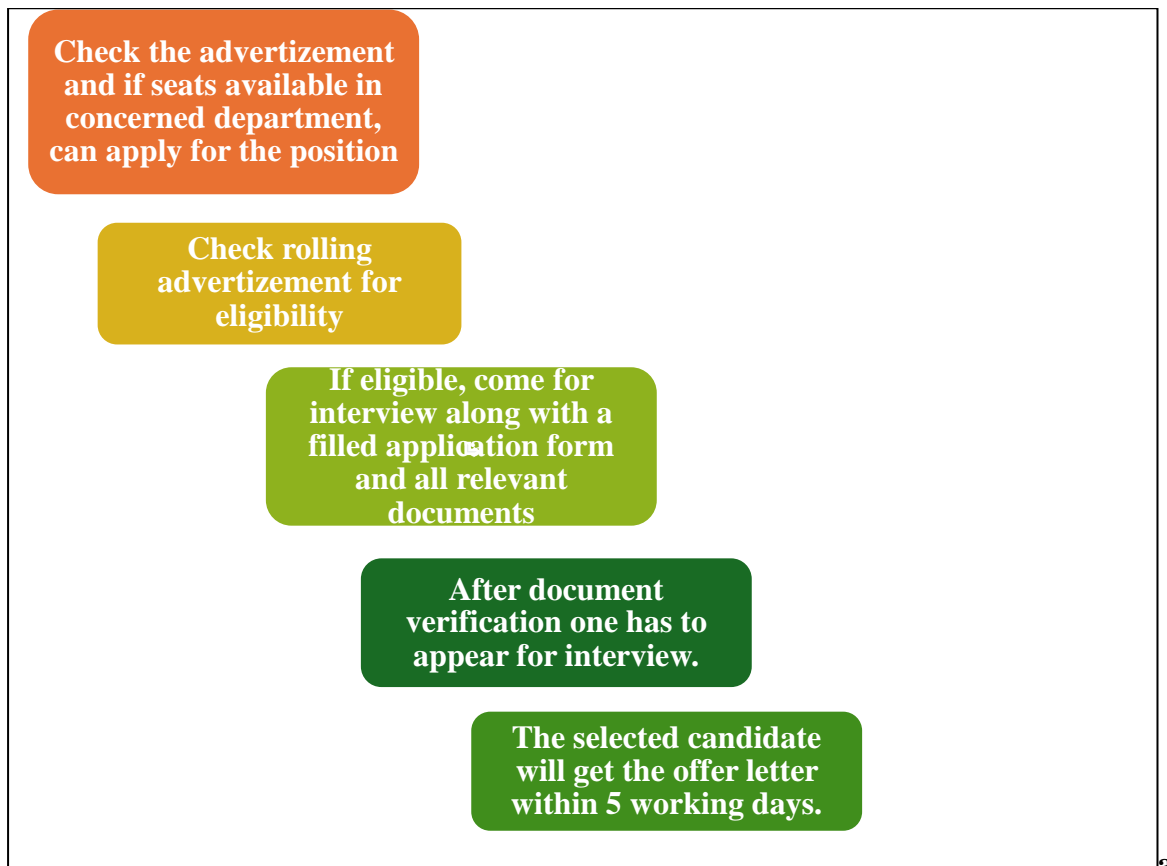
## Duties and responsibilities

The admitted candidates shall require performing such work as may be assigned to them and is necessary in the interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in emergency services as and when required. All can be posted anywhere in SGPGIMS by the competent authority.

## Hostel accommodation:

All Senior Residents, Junior Resident, Medical Physics Residents, Senior Demonstrator and Statistical Fellows are required to reside in the campus. They are provided semi-furnished hostel as per the rules and policy of the Institute.
