 - iii. Publication charges/ reprints/ off prints of research papers published as an outcome of the research.
 - iv. Data entry charges
 - v. Printing of questionnaire
 - vi.Comp^{*} er utilities, charges for analysis of data (computer chalges)
 - $vii.Typin_{\epsilon}$ of research reports including preparation of the final report viii.POL
 - ix. Communication charges
 - x. The grant cannot be used for purchase of furniture items/ office equipments such as telephone, fax machine, computers etc.
- B. For contingency grant exceeding Rs.25,000/- per annum detailed breakup should be given.
- V. Extension beyond the approved duration would not be entertained. If interesting/important leads emerge that need to be followed-up, a separate proposal may be submitted. Only in exceptional cases, where a valid justification exists, and recommended by the Technical Evaluation Committee and Project Approval Committee an extension can be considered to complete the project.
- VI. The host Institute would be required to submit an annual progress report and also give audited statement of expenditure by the Auditor of the research Organization/Institute etc. However, the first progress report should be submitted at least three months prior to the completion of the annual report.
- VII. At the completion of the project, the final report should be sent in the prescribed format. The report should be submitted not later three months from the complete of
