A meeting was held on 17.04.2023 at 3 PM in the College of Medical Technology and AHSc to discuss the issues of the students related to CMT



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
for their achievements as they have influenced a lot of people to take positive actions for the betterment of the country.

A disaster is a serious problem occurring over a short or long period of time that causes widespread human, material, economic or environmental loss which exceeds the ability of the affected community or society to cope using its own resources. Disaster is divided into natural disasters and manmade disasters.

Natural disaster example: Avalanches, flooding, drought, earthquakes etc.

Man made disaster examples: fire, war, civil war etc.

Emergency response plans deal with protecting people first, property second. Emergency responses should attempt to contain, control, or end the emergency. This includes evacuating buildings, fighting fires, turning off utilities, and other response activities.

As a part of Disaster management and emergency response plan, a fire safety training session was organised by Dr. Radha K Principal CON SGPGIMS and coordinated by Mrs Pushpa Singh (tutor), Ms. Alice joseph (tutor) with the cooperation of Mr. Sanjay Srivastava from Fire Department SGPGIMS on 19/12/2022 from 11 am to 12 pm and 20/12/2022 12pm to 1pm at the college campus.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES: At the end of fire safety skill training session the student will be able to:

- A. List ways to prevent fire accidents.
- B. Explain what a smoke detector is and what it does.
- C. Provide the 5 steps necessary for an escape plan
- D. Demonstrate the stop -drop-roll/ "P.A.S.S" technique for extinguishing fire
- E. Protect life and property from fire and maintain the continuity of operation

In this training session, the fire department officers explained the fire and fire extinguishers with the demonstration of fire safety alarming system and demonstration of fire extinguisher and water jet extinguishers.

PARTICIPANTS:

In this fire safety drill, Principal CON, all faculty members, non teaching staff and 46 students of BSc. nursing semester I, 48 students of BSc. Nursing II year year,38 students of III year and 44 students of IV year actively participated and demonstrated the working of different types of fire extinguishers.

After the fire safety training session students were assessed and re-demonstrated on fire Emergency and its management. It was a great learning activity for students as well faculty members to respond in fire emergency situations.

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
