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PRESS RELEASE

A best practice is more than practice, based on evidence. It represents quality care which is deemed optimal. Best practices are health practices, methods, interventions, procedures or techniques based on high-quality evidence in order to obtain improved patient and health outcomes. However, evidence alone is not sufficient to ensure evidencebased decision making but requires uptake and sustained implementation of the evidence. Globally evidence-based products such as best practice guidelines or standards are developed and made available, but the challenge remains to get evidence implemented and then rolled-out into everyday practice and clinical decision making.

The Hospital Infection Control Cell working under the aegis of **Department of Hospital Administration SGPGIMS**, which is also a key stakeholder of SGPIMS Hospital Infection Control Committee (SHICCOM) tasked to taper down the hospital infection profile organized a **Workshop on Best Practices & Best Outcomes vis-à-vis IV Access & Care Bundle** in collaboration with **Hospital Infection Society- India, Lucknow Chapter** at H. G. Khurana Auditorium, SGPGIMS.

A host of activities was lined up for the program, that has been structured into six session in the span of four days. In this context, we are organizing a workshop on sample collection along with **mannequin & dummy arms based hands on training** on two parallel skillstations for our In-service nursing staff. We intend to train **475+ nursing staff** from various patient care area *with a strength of 80 per batch*.

The program began at 02:00 PM with the welcome note & opening remark of **Dr. R. Harsvardhan** Member Secretary, SHICCOM & HoD, Hospital Administration followed by a deliberation by the Chief Guest, **Dr. Gaurav Agarwal** Chairman, SHICCOM & CMS, SGPGIMS on **IV Access w.r.t HIC & Prevention.** The **binannual newsletter** of SGPIMS Hospital Infection Control Committee (SHICCOM) **was released** followed by the distribution **certificates & prizes** for the winners of Posters & Rangoli competition conducted on World Hand Hygiene Day, 2022 held on 5th May, 2022.

The scientific part comprised of dedicated lectures on **Central line care bundle: best practices** from **Dr. Afzal Azim** with live demonstrations on **Peripheral line care bundle: best practices** upon mannequin. **Dr. Richa Mishra**, Addl. Prof., Deptt. of Microbiology deliberated on the topic of **Blood culture collection: best practices** with live demonstration on **IV Lines Care Bundle** upon mannequin. The event concluded with the vote of thanks by Dr.Anitta Jose E., Senior Resident, Deptt. of Hospital Administration. Keynotes from the deliberation of the domain experts were as mentioned vide infra:

- Concept of Bundle Care & its core component
- Central line Bundle & its Care
- Maintenance of CVP line
- Transportation of Blood Sample & Blood Cultures
- Collection of Blood Sample for Culture
- Frequency & timing of Blood Collection
- Culture of Intravascular catheter tips for line sepsis
- Overview of Venepuncture practice
- Blood Collection through indewelling lines

Over 160 delegates, including newly recruited nursing officer & senior nursing staff, attended this workshop which has been instrumented through the endeavors of **Dr. Gaurav Agarwal**, Chairman, SHICCOM & CMS, SGPGIMS & **Dr. R. Harsvardhan**, Member Secretary, SHICCOM & HoD, Hospital Administration. This workshop expected a participation of over **475+ delegates in this 4 day long workshop**. There was immense contribution of **Dr. Richa Mishra, Member**, SHICCOM & Addl.
